

EDITORIAL CHECKLIST: JOURNALS

Please ensure that when submitting your paper to Earthscan, your paper has the following:

- Complete corresponding author contact details: Name, mailing address, email address and telephone number. For papers where there is more than one author, please provide the email address of at least one of the co-authors.
- Complete author affiliation.
- The article type.
- The full title and preferred running head for each article.
- An abstract of a maximum 200 words. The following article types do not need these components: Editorials, viewpoints, book review, meeting reports. Abstracts should not contain references.
- A maximum of ten keywords.
- Figures: All figures must be supplied as greyscale. This should be communicated to the authors and there should be no reference in the text to colour in the figures. All figures should be a minimum of 300 dpi to ensure print quality. Each figure should be numbered and have a caption. Figures should be grouped at the end of each article, or supplied in a separate file delivered with the text file, with a note in the text indicating placement.
- Tables: All tables must be supplied as greyscale. This should be communicated to the authors and there should be no reference in the text to colour in the tables. All tables should be numbered and have captions. They should be grouped at the end of each article, or supplied in a separate file, delivered with the text file, with a note in the text indicating placement.
- References: Please ensure that work is fully referenced and the references are in the journal style.
- Word count: The word count of each paper should include the title, abstract, keywords, references and author information. Please ensure that papers submitted to Earthscan conform with the agreed word count guidelines communicated to the author. Total article word count including references should be taken into consideration when compiling each issue run order.

Papers that are found to be missing the information above will be returned for completion. This is likely to delay the production schedule so please ensure that all papers are correctly formatted before they are sent through. Thank you.
