Published since 1992, the *Manual* has been restructured and refocused to give it a truly pan-European perspective. The *Manual of European Environmental Policy* is written by the Institute for European Environmental Policy (IEEP).

An understanding of EU environmental law and its effects is essential for individuals and organizations concerned with environmental policy, either at the national or international level. However, as the body of EU legislation grows, and the nature of environmental policy evolves, it is getting increasingly difficult to keep up with the developments and their implications. Hence the need for a reliable and systematic *Manual*, updated regularly and combining a guide to individual measures with the necessary background and context.
